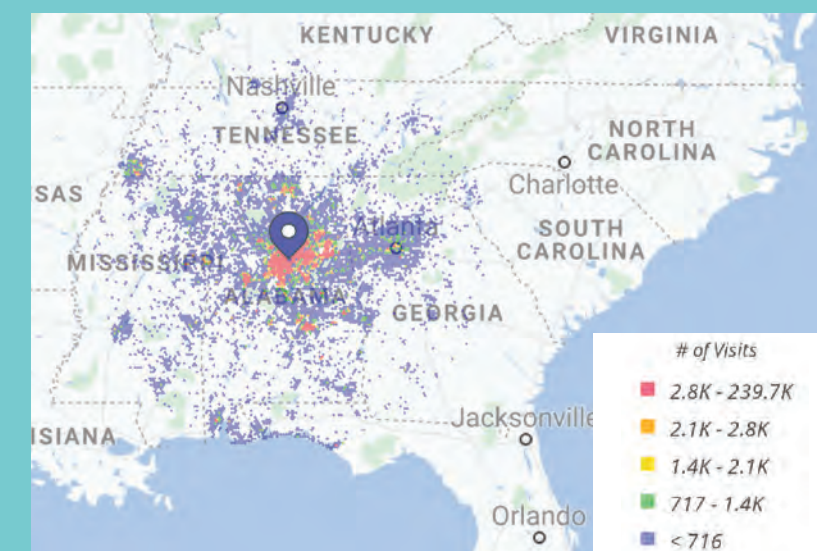

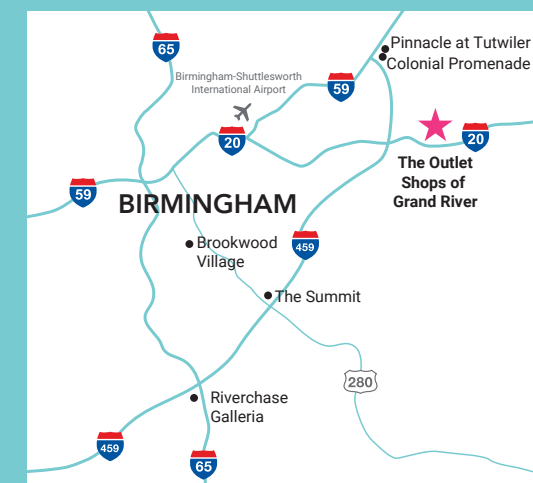
The Birmingham Market

- 12 miles to Birmingham International Airport.
- Home to 26 colleges and universities, with a student population of more than 157,000, within a 75-mile radius.
- Birmingham ranks seventh among the 150 largest U.S. metro areas for percentage increase in millennial residents (ages 25-34).
- Vulcan, the mythical god of metalworking, is the largest cast-iron statue in the world and second in size only to the Statue of Liberty. The statue sits high atop Red Mountain as a symbol of Birmingham's birth in the iron and steel industry.
- Birmingham has a thriving economy, driven by healthcare, banking, professional services, engineering, construction, and automotive manufacturing.
- Both Honda and Mercedes employ over 4,000 people at their Birmingham-area manufacturing plants.

It's All Happening Here.

It's not just about what's inside The Outlet Shops of Grand River. It's also about what's all around us. Our property is centrally located within the 6,500-acre planned community of Grand River, which has become a high-growth area along the I-20 corridor between Birmingham and Atlanta. Our stores are anchored at Exit 140, which features the popular destinations listed at right, with more developments on the way. Each year, over 7 million people come to Grand River to visit The Outlet Shops, Bass Pro, Buc-ee's, and Barber Motorsports Park, and attend events such as the Honda Indy Grand Prix of Alabama.



Area Attractions

Buc-ee's
If you've never been to Buc-ee's, buckle up. The legendary convenience store chain prides itself on setting records—like the world's largest convenience store, the world's longest carwash, and the world's cleanest restrooms. Located just off Interstate 20, which runs from Texas to South Carolina and draws 73 thousand cars a day, our local Buc-ee's features 120 gas pumps and a 53,250-square-foot retail store. The famed fuel stop draws travelers—and it's located just across the interchange from The Outlet Shops of Grand River.

Barber Motorsports Park
One of the world's premier racing circuits, Barber Motorsports Park is home to the Honda Indy Grand Prix of Alabama, and the largest Porsche driving experience in the world. Located just four miles from The Outlet Shops of Grand River, the 880-acre, multi-purpose racing facility also includes the Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum, which boasts the largest collection of motorcycles in the world—with more than 600 bikes on display. Racing fans who visit Grand River are just a quick dash away from several other top motorsports destinations: Talladega Superspeedway, the Harley Davidson U.S. Test Facility, and the International Motorsports Hall of Fame are all less than a 45-minute drive.



Bass Pro Shops Outdoor World
Bass Pro Outdoor World, located on the South side of the I-20 interchange across from The Outlet Shops of Grand River, is more than a hunting and fishing store. As the world's leading supplier of outdoor products, it is part museum, art gallery, education, conservation, and entertainment center. The 135,000-square-foot facility attracts locals and tourists with its wide selection and family-friendly events.

New Home Development Under Construction

Leeds is growing—and our future is getting more upscale. Over 1,800 new homes are being constructed within five miles of The Outlet Shops of Grand River.

The Grand River Parkway Bridge

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2022/2023 on the Grand River Parkway Bridge. Located at the north end of the shopping center on Grand River Parkway, the bridge will span the Cahaba River, connecting the 3,000 acres to the north, where the new sports park and residential community will be built, with the shopping center and other attractions to the south.

New Regional Sports Park

An all-new, 275-acre, state-of-the-art sports complex is coming to Grand River, with construction planned to begin in 2022. Youth sports are big here—and the new park will serve as a hub for regional competitive tournaments, serving soccer, lacrosse, baseball, softball, track & field, basketball, volleyball, and pickleball. Plans include the addition of an arena, equestrian center, and recreational areas in later phases. More families in the area means more visitors to The Outlet Shops of Grand River—making this development a home run. The sports park is projected to open in 2024.

Grand River North Residential Community

This new, master-planned residential community will be located directly north of The Outlet Shops of Grand River, surrounding the Alabama Dreams Park. The initial plan includes 533 acres and 991 single-family homes.

West Tract and Regional Retail Site

Grand River continues to grow—and more projects are on the way. Up to 475,000 square feet of complementary retail, restaurant, and hotel space will be developed, along with the new sports facility, on land adjacent to The Outlet Shops of Grand River. The project is scheduled for completion in 2024.

Future Home of the Southern Museum of Flight

The Southern Museum of Flight is one of the largest aviation museums in the Southeast, housing over 100 aircraft, as well as engines, models, artifacts, photographs, and paintings. The popular Alabama attraction is relocating next to the Grand River Tech Park, on land adjacent to the Barber Motorsports Park and Museum. The new 24-acre museum will be interdisciplinary and multidimensional, featuring hands-on exhibits, a park with aircraft displays, hiking and biking trails, and an outdoor amphitheater. Its opening is scheduled for 2024.
